Impact Thesis

Improve livelihoods of smallholder farmers by increasing their income and food security.

Impact in Practice

Alphonsine, a 24-year-old farmer from Rwamagana, Rwanda, experienced the transformative power of One Acre Fund when her parents' harvest grew from just one bag to five. Inspired by the impact, she knew she wanted to be part of it. "That's why I didn't hesitate to join," she says. Since enrolling in 2020, Alphonsine has significantly increased her own yields. With the surplus, she began selling crops and generating extra income-enough to open a small shop and invest in solar lamps to light both her home and business. "Now I can serve my customers late into the evening because I have light," she shares proudly.

Key Updates

- In 2024, One Acre Fund served 5 million households for the first time, including 2 million through their core program.
- At COP29, One Acre Fund led panels and engaged policymakers to amplify farmers' voices in global climate discussions.
- In April 2024, One Acre Fund reached a milestone of 250 million trees planted cumulatively since 2019, concluding Phase 1 of their effort to plant 1 billion trees by 2030.
